Home Learning Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

This year, we are changing the way that we offer our children home learning opportunities. Each week, the children will bring home a sheet that allows them the chance to practice their handwriting, their multiplication tables and their spellings. These sheets will vary each week but will extend and consolidate the children's understanding and skills in these areas.

As well as this, the children will bring home a Learning Grid. The grid has a range of activities that the children can complete during the half term, this could be: daily, weekly, or slightly less frequent. The grid offers children the chance to develop a range of skills while outside of school, these include their understanding of British Values and SMSC (Social, Moral, Spiritual, Cultural), knowledge of artists, musician, poets and authors.

Also, the children will be able to complete a half-termly project, focussing on one artist, artistic style or movement. This will allow children to use a range of artistic or design skills.
